- Per section 106.1 the Residential Building Official may require additional drawings, technical data or documentation in order to verify compliance.
- A registered electrical contractor with Champaign County Building Regulations Department or homeowner must perform electrical work.
- Homeowner/occupant definition: individual that owns and occupies the dwelling where work is to be preformed for at least one year.
