THE LAST TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE VISIBLE IN OHIO WAS IN 1806. THE NEXT TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE IN OHIO WILL BE IN THE YEAR 2099.



HOW TO VIEW

THE #1 RULE FOR OBSERVING A SOLAR ECLIPSE, OR FOR LOOKING DIRECTLY AT THE SUN AT ANY OTHER TIME, IS SAFETY FIRST. TO VIEW THE ECLIPSE SAFELY, USE ISO 12312-2 COMPLIANT ECLIPSE GLASSES OR A SOLAR VIEWER.

HOW TO PREPARE

SHELTER IN PLACE!

- Stock up on food, medicine, bottled water, diapers, etc. to last several days.
- Fill up any gas-powered machines as gas prices will increase and the elevated population will make traveling difficult.
- Refill the propane for your generator or other propane-powered device.
- Reschedule any medical appointments for the days prior to or after the eclipse.

THE DAY OF...

- Expect roadways and businesses to either be busy or closed due to the increase in population.
- Expect large crowds in public areas.
- High volume of cell phone/internet connectivity issues.
- All county schools will be closed.

WHAT TO EXPECT

BE PREPARED

- With the visitor population of Champaign County expected to greatly increase, your business may experience more foot traffic and potential sales.
- Supply chain issues could arise with the expected traffic during the eclipse.
- Safety precautions should be put into place as emergency services could be in high demand.
- Adjust schedules to account for traffic to help employees and deliveries.
- Stock essential supplies in your business to prepare for shortages and emergencies.
- Coordinate with authorities and neighboring businesses to help be prepared in the case of an emergency.
